## **Let's Make Beautiful Things Together**

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive @ But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?



First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

## Contents:

1 White top folding card base 1 Large white cardstock panel 1 Small white cardstock panel 6 pieces of string 9 heart die cuts: 2 Dark Teal, 3 Medium Teal,

2 Light Teal, and 2 Black line

1 Black sentiment

1 Coordinating envelope\*

Foam squares

1 Foam panel

1 Small white cardstock piece (mailing liner-only needed if you mail your card)\*\*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You will need the small white cardstock panel, the string, the die cut hearts (except 1 medium teal and 1 light teal), the black sentiment and the foam squares.

- 1. The small white card stock panel will be your card front. The back of it has lines drawn on it. Those are the measurements that determine where your string is placed. Add a piece of double-sided tape next to those lines on both the left and right side of the card panel. This will be what holds the string ends in place. Use the example picture for reference.
- 2. Stretch each string across the front of the card and secure its end to the back of the panel- keeping it aligned to its coordinating position. Press the string end into the double-sided tape to keep it secured.
- 3. Next we will add our heart die cuts. Use foam squares to adhere the hearts to your card front. You will use three foam squares for each heart: 2 towards the very top and 1 at the very bottom. This will leave room for the strings to pass under each heart. For heart placement ideas use the example picture for reference.
- 4. Next, adhere your sentiment to the bottom left corner of your card front. Trim it to the desired length. Great!! That's your card front.
- 5. Using double-sided tape adhere your card front to your foam panel.
- 6. Lastly, adhere the card front to your card base making sure to leave an even border of white along each edge.

## Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

- 1. Adhere the stitched white panel to the inside of your card base.
- 2. Adhere your remaining heart die cuts to your stitched panel for added decoration

And you did it!
