## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive <sup>(2)</sup> But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

#### Contents:

1 top folding card base 1 white panel with blue scallops towards the left
1 white panel with blue scallops towards the bottom right (for inside your card)
1 Colored cat die cut
1 Blank cat die cut
1 Colored cat bed die cut
1 Blank cat bed die cut
1 Blank cat bed die cut
1 Turquoise cardstock panel
Sequins and embellishments
1 Foam panel Foam squares
1 Coordinating envelope\*
1 Small white cardstock piece (mailing line)



1 Small white cardstock piece (mailing liner, only needed if you mail your card)\*\*

Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

For this card you have the option to use your pre-colored cat and cat bed elements or you can color your own!

You will need the White card stock panel with the blue scallops towards the left, Colored cat die cut, Colored cat bed die cut, 'I miss you' sentiment and the Sequins and Embellishments.

1. Adhere the bottom portion of the cat to the top section of the cat bed so that he looks like he's sitting on it. Only use glue on the bottom portion of the cat that connects with the cat bed.

2. Use foam squares to adhere the cat and cat bed element to the blue scallop portion of your panel. I placed mine slightly to the bottom left.

3. Use foam squares to adhere the 'I miss you' sentiment next to the cat. I positioned mine towards the upper right.

4. Using liquid glue, adhere the Sequins and Embellishments around your Cat and 'I miss you' sentiment.

That's your card front panel! For added dimension, adhere your foam panel to the back of your card front panel (this step is optional). Adhere your card front to the white card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

# Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

 Adhere your remaining scalloped white cardstock panel to your turquoise cardstock panel making sure to leave an even border of turquoise showing along each edge.
 Adhere that panel to the inside of your card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
