## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ③ But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents: 1 Black top-folding card base 2 Striped pieces with torn edges 1 Black triangle patterned paper 3 White hello die cuts 1 Glitter hello die cut 2 Foam panel pieces 1 Pink cardstock panel 1 White cardstock panel 2 Narrow white cardstock strips Sequins and embellishments 1 Coordinating envelope \*

Let's Begin!



We'll construct the card front first.

You will need the two striped pieces with torn edges, the black triangle patterned paper, all of the hello die cuts, the two foam panel pieces and the sequins and embellishments.

1. Adhere the corresponding foam panels to the back of your striped pieces. This will add dimension to the finished card.

2. Adhere your 3 white hello die cuts together. This creates a thicker and stronger die cut sentiment. I prefer to use small dots of liquid glue for this. It gives just a little bit of time to align them before the glue dries. Finish by adding your glitter hello die cut to the top

3. Adhere your black triangle paper to the center of the front of your card base, making sure to leave an even border of black showing along the left and right edge.

4. Now adhere your two striped pieces to the card front aligning them with the left and right edge of your triangle piece. Make sure to leave an even border of black showing along the top and bottom edge.

5. Adhere your stacked hello die cut to your card front. And add your sequins and embellishments for decoration. For design ideas, use the card example.

And that's it!

## Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere your white panel to your pink panel making sure to leave an even border of pink showing long each edge.

2. Adhere your 2 white cardstock strips towards the bottom of your card base and add your pink layered panel towards the top. For design ideas, use the card example.
