Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Top-folding card base
- 1 Large white square panel
- 1 Small white square panel
- 1 Linen square panel
- 2 Hello word die cuts
- 2 Plain green treetops
- 1 Patterned green treetop
- 1 Patterned oval 3 Brown tree trunks
- 1 Green hillside panel
- 1 Leaf die cut
- 1 Foam panel
- 1 Coordinating envelope*

Let's Begin!



We'll construct the card front first.

You will need the large white square panel, the linen square panel, the three treetops, the three tree trunks, one green oval, and 2 hello word die cuts.

1. Adhere your tree trunks to your treetops. Use the example card for design ideas.

2. Adhere your 2 hello word die cuts together. This creates a thicker and stronger die cut sentiment. I prefer to use small dots of liquid glue for this. It gives just a little bit of time to align them before the glue dries.

3. Using a light application of a strong liquid glue, adhere your linen panel to your large white square.

4. Next use a liquid glue to adhere your green oval to the center of your linen square.

5. Now Arrange your three trees in your favorite pattern. Use The example card for design ideas.

6. Use a liquid glue to adhere your stacked hello die cut to your linen card front.

7. Adhere your foam panel to the back of your card front. Now, adhere your card front to your card base.

And that's it!

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere your green hillside piece to the bottom of your small white square panel.
2. Finally, adhere your green leaf as a decoration.
3. Adhere that panel to the inside of your card base

And you did it!
