## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!

### Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

### Contents:

- 1 white side folding card base
- 1 one green patterned paper
- 1 coral cardstock panel
- 1 white cardstock panel
- 1 large white heart die cut
- 4 colored rainbow pieces
- 1 hello die cut word
- 1 hello die cut background
- 1 small green heart die cut
- 1 Love sentiment
- Mini heart embellishments
- 1 coordinating envelope\*
- 1 Small white cardstock piece (mailing liner-only needed if you mail your card)\*\*

### Let's Begin!



We'll construct the card front first.

You will need the gray patterned paper, the large white heart die cut, the colored rainbow pieces, the Hello die cut background, the Hello die cut word, the mini heart embellishments, and the love sentiment.

1. Adhere the Hello word die cut to the Hello background die cut. You will need to use a light application of liquid glue on the back of the Hello word die cut and carefully position it in place making sure to leave an even border of white along each edge.

2. Adhere the rainbow stripes to the large heart die cut. When centered they hang off the edges. Just turn the heart over and trim the excess.

3. Adhere the Rainbow Heart die cut to the green patterned paper. This is the start of your card front panel. I placed mine off center and then trimmed the excess.

4. Next we will connect the love sentiment to the Hello die cut. Add a little bit of adhesive to the left edge of the love sentiment and tuck it behind the second L of the Hello background.

5. Now add foam squares to the back of the Hello die cut and love sentiment. Adhere that to your card front. I placed mine slightly over the top of the rainbow heart.

6. Add the mini heart embellishments to your card front using liquid glue or glue dots.

7. Lastly adhere your card front to your card base. Make sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

And that's it!

**Now let's decorate the inside of our card!**

1. Adhere the white cardstock panel to the coral cardstock, making sure to leave an even border of coral along each edge.
2. Next adhere that to the inside of your card.
3. Add the small green heart die cut for decoration.



**And you did it!**
