Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 Side folding card base
4 White card stock panels-
all different sizes

1 Leaf panel

1 Polka dot panel

1 Peach panel

1 Navy panel

1 Mom and child die cut

1 Sentiment

1 Heart die cut

Embellishments

1 Mailing liner

(mailing liner, only needed if you mail your card)*1 Coordinating envelope*

Let's Begin!



We'll construct the card front first.

You will need the Largest white card stock panel, the two small stitched white panels, one leaf panel, one polka dot panel, one peach panel, one mom and child die cut, one sentiment, and embellishments

1. Construct the card front on the largest white cardstock panel.
2. You can arrange your stitched panels any way you like. This is how I arranged mine. Use the picture above for reference.
 - a. Layer the polka dot panel on the larger white stitched panel.
 - b. Layer the peach panel onto the smaller white stitched panel.
 - c. Adhere the leaf panel towards the middle of the card front. Trim off the excess.
 - d. Adhere the layered peach panel at the bottom. Trim off excess.
 - e. Adhere the layered polka dot panel. Trim off excess.
3. Adhere the mom and child die cut using the foam squares. Trim the foam squares to fit behind the die cut, making sure to get even coverage.
4. Adhere the sentiment using foam squares.
5. Add embellishments for decoration. Adhere the card front to card base, leaving an even border of white showing along each edge.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the navy panel to the inside of your card, leaving an even border of white showing along each edge.
2. Adhere the white panel on top of it, leaving an even border of navy showing along each edge.
3. Add heart die cut for decoration.



And you did it!
