Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?



First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White side-folding card base
- 1 Gray stamped cloud panel
- 1 Red umbrella
- 1 Light gray torn edge panel
- 1 Red cardstock panel
- 1 Gray cardstock panel
- Foam Dots
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing liner (mailing liner is only needed if you mail your card)**



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the gray stamped cloud panel, the red umbrella, the light gray torn edge piece and the foam dots.

1. Adhere your light gray torn edge piece to your cloud panel so that the image matches just right. I suggest a liquid glue for this so that you can adjust it as needed until it's in place. You will end up with some excess on each side. No problem, just turn your panel over and trim off the extra. Now your girl image should be complete
2. Using your foam dots adhere the red umbrella directly over the stamped one. Now your card front is finished.
3. Adhere that whole panel to your card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the red cardstock panel to the inside of your card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
2. Finally adhere your gray panel over your red panel. Make sure to leave an even border of red showing along each edge.



And you did it!

*Confirm postage needed when mailing

**mailing liner is used as a barrier over the card front to protect it during shipping
