## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White top-folding card base
- 1 White cardstock panel
- 5 White leaf stems (2 large, 2 medium, 1 small)
- 2 White sentiment pieces
- 2 Blue sentiment backers
- 4 Rainbow pieces
- Sequins
- 1 Foam panel
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*
- 1 Mailing liner (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)\*\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the white cardstock panel, the 5 leaf stems, the 2 sentiment pieces, the 2 blue backer pieces and the sequins.

1. Adhere each white sentiment piece to its coordinating blue backer. Make sure to leave an even border of blue showing along each edge.
2. Now adhere the leaf stems to the white panel. I suggest using a liquid glue for this. Just add small drops to the back and when you go to place it, you'll have a brief moment to adjust it, if needed. Make sure not to use too much glue or it'll squish out the sides. If you don't have glue, a tape runner will also work. Use the example picture for placement ideas.
3. Turn your panel over and trim off any excess.
4. Adhere the sentiment strips to your panel over top of the stems. To help keep them level, I recommend just gluing the areas where they rest on top of the stems. That will allow the entire sentiment to stay all one level.
5. Next, use a liquid glue, or mini glue dot, to adhere the sequins for decoration and your card front panel is done.
6. Adhere the foam panel to the back of your card front panel. Your foam panel has adhesive on one side to make this easier!
7. Now, adhere your foam backed card front to your card base.



## **Now let's decorate the inside of our card!**

1. All four rainbow pieces nest together. Begin your rainbow with the small green piece. Adhere it to the inside of your card all the way in the lower right corner. The bottom and right edges should line up with your card edge. Use the example card picture for reference. Be careful it doesn't hang over the card base edge. We should not be able to see it when the card is closed. If you do get any edges peeking out, you can always trim off the excess.
2. Next add the yellow, coral and pink rainbow pieces making sure to line them up at the bottom. I used a liquid glue for this so that I had time to adjust their placement as needed.
