## **Let's Make Beautiful Things Together**

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive © But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

## Contents:

1 White card base

1 Large green panel

4 paper strips

(1 polka dot, 1 peach, 1 leaf, 1 solid)

3 Thanks die cuts (2 white, 1 pearl)

1 Piece of twine

1 Large peach panel

1 Coordinating envelope\*

Let's Begin!



We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the white card base, large green panel, 4 paper strips, "thanks" die cuts and twine.

- 1.Each of your paper strips will need to be torn vertically, top to bottom. Try to make them even. Tear slowly, towards you which will give the torn effect desired. You will need to tear off roughly ¼ inch, which gives you about 1 inch of torn paper to work with on your card front. Do this with all four paper strips. (Note: your polka dot panel is wider than the others. You will still only tear ¼ inch from it.)
- 2. Now let's put together the card front. From right to left, adhere the torn-edged strips of paper to the large green panel. The paper strips will be longer than the green panel. This allows you to adjust your placement. Once they are all glued down, you can trim the excess to match the size of the green panel. To create the stripe effect, leave ½ inch of each color/pattern showing. (see example photo for placement ideas.) You can put the stripes in whatever order you want! I did polka dot, peach, leaf, green, then let the green panel show as the last stripe. When you adhere them, you'll begin with the last strip first and work your way to the left. This will allow the torn edge to show.
- 3. Next, wrap your twine around the lower portion of your card front panel and tie a bow. I wrapped my twine 3 times around!
- 4. Now, glue your 'thanks' die cuts together. Layering the three die cuts together creates a strong and dimensional sentiment. Make sure to have the pearl die cut on top.
- 5. Adhere your die cut above your wrapped twine.

6. Now adhere your card front panel to the front of your card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

## Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

Tear the bottom edge of your large peach panel and adhere it to the inside of your card base.

And you did it!
