Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because t situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ② But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 black card base
1 patterned paper
1 black rectangle
1 white stripe
1 circle die cut with sentiment
1 black frame
1 purple frame
1 white panel
Heart embellishments

Foam squares

1 Mailing liner (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**

1 Coordinating envelope*

Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the patterned paper, black rectangle, white stripe, circle die cut, heart embellishments and foam squares.

- 1 Adhere the white stripe to the black rectangle, centered horizontally.
- 2. Adhere your patterned paper to the front of your card base leaving an even border of black showing along each edge.
- 3. Next, adhere your layered black rectangle over your card front. The black rectangle will need to be trimmed to size after you glue it down to the card base. I placed mine towards the top. (see example picture for placement ideas)
- 4. Using foam squares, adhere your sentiment circle to your card front.
- 5. Add heart embellishments for decoration.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the white panel to the inside of your card base, making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.

2 Using small dots of liquid glue, adhere your black frame to your white panel, leaving an even border of white.



3. Next, using small dots of liquid glue, adhere your purple frame to your white panel, leaving an even border of white. (see example photo for placement ideas)

And you did it!
