Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because t situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ⁽²⁾ But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 white card base
2 light blue panels
6 whole lemon die cuts
12 green leaf die cuts
7 half lemon die cuts with
lemon slice tops
1 thank you sentiment
Foam squares
1 Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your curv)
1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need 1 light blue panel, 5 whole lemon die cuts, 10 green leaf die cuts, 6 half lemon die cuts with lemon slice tops, thank you sentiment and foam squares.

1. Adhere the lemon slice tops to the half lemon die cuts using small dots of liquid glue.

2.Adhere two green leaf die cuts to the underside of a whole lemon die cut. (see photo example for placement ideas). Repeat step for all whole lemon die cuts.

3.Arrange all lemon pieces on your light blue panel and adhere them when you are satisfied with the display arrangement. (see photo example for placement ideas)

4.Trim excess portions that extend beyond the light blue panel.

5. Adhere your card front panel to the front of your card base.

6. Using foam squares, adhere the thank you sentiment to your card front. (easy peasy, lemon squeezy!!)

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Construct your remaining lemon pieces as before.

2. Adhere them to the light blue panel for decoration.

3. Adhere your light blue panel to the inside of your card base, making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

And you did it!
