Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ⁽²⁾ But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

Navy top folding card base
Patterned paper
Large navy frame
Small navy frame
White You Did It die cut
Navy shadow die cut
Hat die cut pieces
hats, 2 hat toppers, 2 tassels)
White card stock panel
Sequins
Foam squares
Coordinating envelope*
mailing liner (mailing liner on



1 mailing liner (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**

Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the patterned paper, the large navy frame, the white You Did It, the navy shadow die cut piece, 1 full hat piece, 1 topper and 1 tassel, the sequins and the foam squares.

1. Let's construct the hat first. Adhere your hat topper to the full hat piece lining them up to match. Next add your tassel. I found it was easier to put a small dab of glue in the center of the topper. Then add the tassel to the glue.

2. Now adhere the You Did It die cut to the navy shadow piece. Don't forget the tittles, that's the little dots to your lower case i's.

3. Adhere your patterned paper panel to the front of your card base. Make sure to leave an even border of blue showing along each edge.

4. Using small dots of liquid glue or a tape runner, adhere your large navy frame to your card front.

5. Use foam squares to adhere the layered "You Did It" and hat die cut. For placement ideas, see my example.

6. Lastly use small dots of liquid glue to adhere your sequins for decoration.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Construct your second hat just like your first.

2. Adhere your white card stock panel to the inside of your card base leaving an even border of blue showing along each edge.

3. Add the small frame and second hat as decoration.

And you did it!
