Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White panel
- 5 colored paper strips
- 1 white heart
- 1 thank you sentiment
- 1 large pink panel
- 1 foam panel
- foam dots
- 3 embellishment dots
- 1 Mailing liner

(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
1 Coordinating envelope*

Let's Begin!



We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the white panel, colored strips, heart, thank you sentiment, embellishment dots and foam pieces.

1 Adhere the paper strips to the white panel. The paper strips will be longer than the white panel. This allows you to adjust your placement. Once they are all glued down, you can trim the excess to match the size of the white panel. (see example photo for placement ideas)

2. Now we're going to adhere your thank you sentiment to the heart die cut. I recommend using small dots of liquid glue.

3. Next, adhere the large foam panel behind your white panel. This will be your card front.

4. Adhere that panel to the front of your card base, making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

5. Next, use the small foam dots to adhere the white heart to your card front.

6. Add embellishments for decoration. (see example photo for placement ideas)

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

Adhere the large pink panel to the inside of your card base.

And you did it!
