Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because t situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ② But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 Black card base

8 watermelon die cuts

(each die cut includes 1 dark green slice,

l light green slice, 1 red slice and one

melon/pink arch and 3 watermelon seed

die cuts)

3 additional watermelon seed die cuts

(for inside card decoration)

Black sentiment piece

Inked "sweet" sentiment

3 red heart embellishments

1 large white panel

1 small white panel

1 red panel

Foam squares

1 Mailing liner (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**

1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

- 1. First, let's construct our watermelon slices. The layers go in this order, start with dark green, then light green, then the red. Match them symmetrically at the bottom point. The pink arch is layered in the space between the red and the light green. Line them up before gluing anything down to make sure you get the spacing right. If things don't seem to be lining up, try flipping the pieces over.
- 2 Add three seeds to each watermelon slice.
- 3. Next, adhere the inked 'sweet' die cut to the black sentiment cut out.
- 4.Arrange all watermelon slices on your white panel and adhere them when you are satisfied with the display arrangement. (see photo example for placement ideas)
- 5. Trim excess portions that extend beyond the white panel.
- 6. Adhere your card front panel to the front of your card base.
- 7 Using foam squares, adhere the "you're sweet" sentiment to your card front.
- 8. Add red heart embellishments to your card front for decoration.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere your red panel to the inside of your card base, making sure to leave an even border of black along each edge.

2. Adhere your white panel to the red panel, making sure to leave an even border of red showing along each edge.

3. Use the remaining watermelon seed die

3. Use the remaining watermelon seed die cuts to decorate the inside of your card. (see photo example for placement ideas)
