Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because that situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Large gray panel (textured)
- 1 Small gray panel (plain)
- 1 Dark gray panel
- 2 Happy die cuts (1 red, 1 white)
- 1 Black strip
- 1 Gray strip
- 1 Sentiment strip
- Embellishment dots
- 1 Foam Panel
- 1 Coordinating Envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the large textured gray panel, the black and gray paper strips, the red and white Happy die cuts, the Father's Day sentiment, the embellishment dots and the foam panel.

1. We'll begin by adhering the 2 paper strips toward the bottom of your gray textured panel. This will be your card front. The black and gray strips are purposefully longer than your panel to make placement easier. After you adhere them, just trim off the excess.
2. Next glue your red Happy die cut on top of the white one. You can see the white die cut has edges for you to line them up correctly. Adhere your layered Happy die cut to your gray panel (card front)
3. Now adhere your Father's Day sentiment to your card front and trim any excess. See example picture for placement ideas.
4. Finally add your embellishment dots for decoration.
5. Adhere the foam panel to the back of your finished gray card front panel.
6. Now adhere your card front to the front of your card base.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the dark gray panel to the inside of your card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

2. Now adhere your small gray panel to the inside of your card base layered on top of the dark gray. Make sure to leave an even border of dark gray showing along each edge.
