Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because t situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ③ But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 Navy card base 1 Large white panel 1 Small white panel 1 Green Text panel 1 Green plain panel Love You die cut letters Embellishment hearts 1 Coordinating Envelope*



Let's Begin!


We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the large white panel, the green text panel, the love you die cut letters, and the embellishment hearts.

- 1. Begin by adhering the Love You letters onto your green text panel. I recommend you place them first to find the right spacing, then glue 1 letter at a time using small dots of liquid glue. Also, using a ruler might help to get them straight.
- 2. Next adhere your green text panel to your large white panel making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
- 3. Now adhere that layered panel to the front of your card base and your card front is almost finished!
- 4. Finally, add your heart embellishments for decoration. I recommend small dots of liquid glue for this. (Use example picture for placement ideas)

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

- 1. Adhere your plain green panel to the inside of your card base making sure to leave an even border of blue showing along each edge.
- 2. Now adhere your small white panel on to the green panel making sure to leave an even border of green showing along each edge.
