Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Black card base
- 1 Inked background panel
- 1 Robot image/ Beep image
- 1 Navy panel
- 1 White cardstock piece
- 1 Father's Day sentiment
- 1 Set HAPPY die cut letters (white)
- 1 Set Happy die cut letters (blue)
- 1 Foam panel
- Foam squares
- 1 Coordinating envelope*
- 1 Mailing liner** (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the inked background panel, the robot image, the beep image, the foam panel and the foam squares.

1. Adhere your foam panel to the back of the inked panel. Next adhere that to the front of your card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.
2. Using foam squares adhere your robot and beep images to your card front. See example picture for placement ideas.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Let's decorate the HAPPY letters first.
Cut each blue letter to create a top layer over the white letters. I did mine a little less than halfway down. See example picture for placement ideas. Using very little glue, carefully adhere the blue letter layer pieces over the white letters. Working with those little letter pieces can be tedious, so this part can be optional ;)
2. Adhere your navy blue panel to the inside of your card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.
3. Now adhere your HAPPY letters to your navy panel. See example picture for placement ideas.



4. Next, adhere your Father's Day sentiment.
5. Finally, adhere your white cardstock piece to your navy panel
