## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because that situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!



## Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

## Contents:

- 1 Vanilla card base
- 1 Large Script paper frame
- 1 Small Script paper frame
- 1 Small Script paper panel
- 3 Black die cut stems
- 1 Kraft brown panel
- Foam Strips
- 1 Mailing liner
- (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)\*\*
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the Card base, the 3 script paper pieces, 2 die cut stems and the foam strips.

1. First, adhere the large script frame to the front of your card base. Make sure to leave an even border of vanilla showing along each edge. I recommend using a dot roller or a light application of a liquid glue. This will allow you to adjust it if needed. (Make sure it's not upside down!)
2. Next fit the small script frame inside the large one but don't glue it down yet. This placement will show you where your inside piece will go.
3. Your next step is to put adhesive in the center, open space and fit your small script panel directly in the center. (tip: keep your small frame loosely in place to get it just right) Make sure to align your pattern and that it's not upside down.
4. It's now time to adhere your small script frame between your outside frame and center piece. First adhere the foam strips to the back of your frame and then adhere it to your card front. Make sure to align the script pattern and that it's not upside down.
5. Now, using small dots of glue, adhere the 2 stem die cuts together. This adds dimension and strength to the die cut.
6. Adhere your layered die cut to the center of your card front.

**Now let's decorate the inside of our card!**

1. Adhere the kraft brown panel to the inside of your card, making sure to leave an even border of vanilla showing along each edge.
2. Adhere your remaining die cut stem for decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.
