## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White Card Base
- 1 Inked Background panel
- 4 Rainbow pieces
- 1 Small cloud die cut
- 1 Cloud pane
- 1 Sweet die cut
- 1 Baby background die cut
- 1 Baby word die cut
- 1 Pink panel
- 2 Cloud border die cuts
- Foam squares
- Foam panel
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*
- 1 Mailing Liner\*\* (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)

Let's Begin!



We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the inked background panel, the 4 rainbow pieces, the small cloud die cut, the cloud panel, the Sweet die cut, the Baby word die cut, the Baby background die cut, and the foam pieces.

1. Let's construct the rainbow first. Lay them out to see how the sizes fit together. You have an extra large, large, medium, and small arch. Adhere the smallest (and lightest in color) to the medium arch. Align it at the bottom of the arch. The small will cover the lower half of the medium and line up on each end. Layer and adhere each one this way until all 4 pieces create the rainbow. See example picture for help.
2. Using a strong liquid glue adhere the Baby word die cut to the glitter background so you see an even border around each edge.
3. Now adhere the Sweet die cut and layered 'Baby' die cut to the Cloud panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
4. Arrange your rainbow, small cloud die cut and cloud panel on your inked background panel. This is to help you confirm their placement. Once you're happy with your design, adhere your rainbow in place on your background panel.
5. Next, use foam squares to adhere your small cloud die cut to the end of your rainbow on your background panel.
6. Adhere your foam panel to the back of your cloud panel.
7. Now use liquid glue to adhere your cloud panel onto your background panel. Make sure to line up the scallop edges so they match. See example picture for help.
8. Finally adhere your constructed card front to your white card base making sure to leave an even border showing along each edge.

**Now let's decorate the inside of our card!**

1. Adhere the pink panel to the inside of your card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
2. Now arrange your cloud border pieces for decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.
