## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Inked background panel
- 1 Welcome die cut
- 1 Giraffe die cut
- 1 Piece of ribbon
- 2 shades of blue circle die cuts
- 1 Coral circle die cut
- 1 Foam panel
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*
- 1 Mailing Liner\*\*

(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)

Let's Begin!



We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the inked background panel, the Welcome die cut, the giraffe die cut, the piece of ribbon and the foam panel.

1. Decide where you want to add your ribbon. Mark the BACK of your background panel. Place a piece of double sided tape where your ribbon will lay across the BACK of your panel. You will not need adhesive on the front of your panel to hold your ribbon in place. Stretch your ribbon behind your panel (over your tape) bringing the ends of your ribbon to the front and tie a knot. Trim your ends to the desired length.
2. Now, using small dots of liquid glue, adhere the Welcome die cut to the front of your inked panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
3. Add a small amount of adhesive to the back of the giraffe die cut and adhere him to the inked panel by tucking him under the ribbon. See example picture for placement ideas.
4. Adhere the foam panel to the back of the inked background panel. Now adhere your constructed card front to the front of your card base.

**Now let's decorate the inside of our card!**

Adhere the circles to the inside of your card base for decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.

**And you did it!**
