Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because that situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Black card base
- 1 Script panel
- Several black mandala die cuts
- 3 Black "Love" die cuts
- 1 Gold "Love" die cuts
- 1 Vanilla panel
- 1 Foam panel
- 1 Mailing liner
- (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the Card base, the script panel, the mandala die cuts, the "Love" die cuts and the foam panel.

1. We'll begin by adhering the mandalas to the script panel. It's a little tricky to glue these down. Here's how I did it. Lightly moisten the corner of a folded up paper towel. Then add liquid glue to that same corner and use it like a sponge. Tap the glue covered paper towel on to the back of the mandala die cuts. Try not to get glue on the front of the mandalas.
2. Now turn the script panel over and trim off all excess of the mandalas. Save the excess trimmings to decorate the inside of your card.
3. Using small dots of liquid glue adhere the 3 black "Love" die cuts together to make a more dimensional sentiment. Adhere the gold "Love" die cut as the top layer.
4. Now adhere your stacked "Love" die cut to the decorated script panel. See example picture for placement ideas. This is your card front.
5. Next, adhere the foam panel to your decorated card front.
6. Now adhere your card front to the front of your black card base.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Use the trimmings from your mandalas to decorate the vanilla panel. Trim off any excess. See example picture for placement ideas.
2. Lastly, adhere your decorated vanilla panel to the inside of your card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.



And you did it!
