Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because t situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ② But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 White card base

1 Light blue panel with white embossing

1 Piece of white string

1 Gray heart die cut

1 Hi die cutl Gray panel

1 White frame die cut

1 Foam squares

1 Foam strips

1 Mailing liner

(mailing liner only needed if you

mail your card)**

1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the light blue panel, the white string, the gray heart, the Hi die cut and the foam pieces.

- 1. Using a double sided tape, adhere one end of the white string to the back of the light blue panel- towards the bottom. Then wrap the string around the panel twice and secure it to the back again with double sided tape. Once secure, trim the excess string. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 2. Next, adhere the foam strips to the back of the light blue panel. Arrange them so that most of the panel is covered.
- 3. Now adhere the panel to the front of your card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
- 4. Using foam squares, adhere the gray heart inside the center of the circle.
- 5. Now use small dots of liquid glue to adhere the Hi die cut to the gray heart. Tip: For the dot of the 'i 'place a small dot of glue down first and then set the dot onto the glue.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

- 1. Using small dots of liquid glue, adhere the white frame to the gray panel making sure to leave an even border along each edge. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 2. Now adhere the decorated gray panel to the inside of your card base.



And you did it!
