

# Snail Mail Kit B

## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!

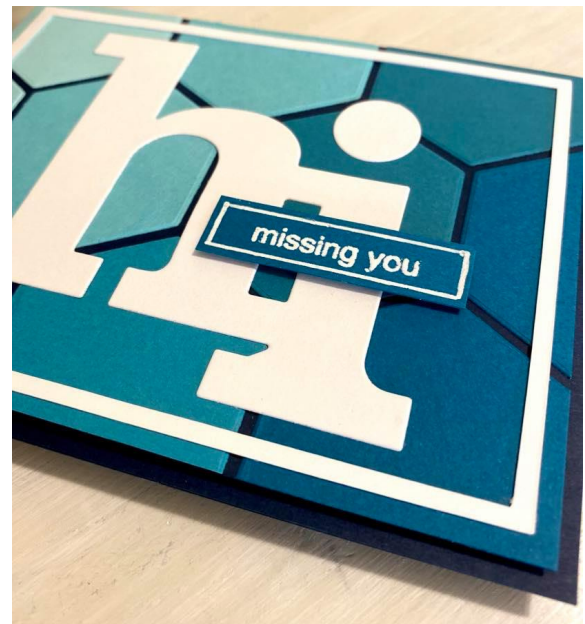


## Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

## Contents:

- 1 Navy card base
- 1 Navy panel
- 10 Hexagon die cuts  
(2 each of 5 shades of blue)
- 1 Stamped sentiment
- 1 Hi die cut
- 1 White frame
- 1 Teal panel
- 1 White strip
- 1 Foam panel
- 1 Mailing liner  
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)\*\*
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the Navy panel, the hexagon die cuts, the Hi die cut, the stamped sentiment, the white frame and the foam pieces.

1. Begin by adhering the 2 centrally placed hexagons, first. Keep the spacing even between them. Making sure these first two hexagons are straight will help keep the whole pattern aligned.
2. Next add the rest of the hexagons. It might help to lay out the pattern first and then adhere them in place. Take care to keep the spacing even between each hexagon. Once all hexagons are adhered in place turn the panel over and trim off the excess. See example picture for placement ideas.
3. Now, using a light application of glue, adhere the white frame onto the hexagon panel.
4. Next adhere the Hi die cut on to the hexagon panel.
5. Using a foam square, adhere the stamped sentiment to the card front. See example picture for placement ideas.
6. Now adhere the foam panel to the back of your constructed card front. (I recommend a strong double sided tape) After that, adhere the card front to your card base making sure to leave an even border of navy showing along each edge.

**Now let's decorate the inside of our card!**

1. Adhere the white paper strip to the light teal panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
2. Trim off any excess. And adhere the teal panel to the inside of your card base making sure to leave an even border of navy showing along each edge.

**And you did it!**
