Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because t situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ② But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

1 Coordinating envelope*

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 White card base
2 White with purple inked panels
(1 for the inside)
2 White Happy die cuts with inside outlines
1 Stamped sentiment
Purple striped letter pieces
1 Foam panel
1 Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need 1 inked panel, the white Happy die cut pieces, the purple letter pieces, the stamped sentiment and the foam panel.

- 1. Begin by adhering the 2 white Happy die cuts together. This creates a stronger and more dimensional die cut. Adhere together the small pieces that make up the inside outlines too.
- 2. Now adhere the stacked Happy outline die cut to the card front. Tip: use small dots of liquid glue for adhesive
- 3. Next, add small dots of liquid glue onto the back of each purple letter. Then snap them into place inside the Happy outline.
- 4. Finish this step by adhering the inside outline pieces.
- 5. Next adhere the stamped sentiment onto the card front. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 6. Now adhere the foam panel to the back of your constructed card front. (I recommend a strong double sided tape) After that, adhere the card front to your card base, making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the other inked panel to the inside of your card base, making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
