#### Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive <sup>(2)</sup> But you can always just use what you have!




### Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

## Contents:

Black card base
Black inked and splattered panel
Dark purple panel
Light purple panel
Ghost die cuts
Ghost arm die cuts (6 left, 6 right)
White "Boo!" die cuts
Glittered black "Boo!" die cut
Foam squares
Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you
mail your card)\*\*
Coordinating envelope\*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the black splattered panel, the dark purple panel, 5 ghost die cuts with coordinating arms, all "Boo!" die cuts and the foam squares.

- 1. Let's begin by constructing the ghosts. I've included 1 extra ghost for decorating the inside of your card. You can set it aside for now. For the 5 card front ghosts, carefully trim the left and right bump off of the ghost form. This makes the shape straight on each side.
- 2. Now arrange the ghost arms to coordinate with the ghosts. Each ghost will have a left and a right arm. Each left arm has a hand pointing left. Each right arm has a hand pointing right. Adhere the arms to the back of each ghost. Tip: Arrange each ghost how you want it. Lift the ghost form up, apply glue to each arm, set ghost form down on top of the arms and adjust placement as needed.
- 3. After that, construct the layered sentiment. First adhere the 2 white "Boo!" words together with one on top of the other. This creates a stronger and more dimensional word. Next adhere the black sentiment on top making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge. See example picture.
- 4. Now arrange the ghost and "Boo!" pieces on the splattered panel to find the best placement. Once the arrangement is decided, adhere the ghosts in place. (Don't adhere the sentiment yet) Turn the panel over and trim any excess that hangs off.
- 5. Using foam squares, adhere the "Boo!" sentiment in place..
- 6. Now adhere the constructed front panel to the dark purple panel making sure to leave an even border of purple showing along each edge.
- 7. Finally, adhere the layered card front to the black card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.

## Now let's decorate the inside of the card!

- 1. Use the extra ghost to embellish the inside of your card by adhering it to the light purple panel. Get creative! There's no wrong way to do it.
- 2. Adhere the decorated purple panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.

And you did it!
