#### Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive <sup>(2)</sup> But you can always just use what you have!



#### Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

#### Contents:

Blue card base
White panel
Flower panell Sentiment hexagon
White panel with ink blending
Heart die cut
Sequins
Foam square
Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you
mail your card)\*\*
Coordinating envelope\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the plain white panel, the flower panel, the sentiment, the sequins and the foam square.

- 1. Begin by adhering the flower panel to the white panel making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
- 2. Using the foam square, adhere the sentiment to the flower panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 3. Using small dots of liquid glue or glue dots, adhere the sequins to the flower panel as decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 4. Next adhere your decorated card front to the blue card base making sure to leave an even border of blue showing along each edge.

## Now let's decorate the inside of the card!

- 1.Adhere the white panel with ink blending to the inside of the card base.
- 2.Add the heart die cut for decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.

## And you did it!
