## **Let's Make Beautiful Things Together**

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ② But you can always just use what you have!



### Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

#### Contents:

1 White card base

1 White panel

1 White cut out frame

6 Stocking die cuts

3 Noel die cuts

Sequins

1 Red panel

1 Coordinating envelope\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the white panel, the cut out frame, the stocking die cuts, the noel die cuts and the sequins.

- 1. Begin by adhering the white cut out frame to the white panel. It will align at each edge.
- 2. Next, adhere the 6 stocking die cuts over top of the layered cut out piece. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 3. Adhere the 3 Noel die cuts together making sure to align them at all edges. This helps to add dimension and make the die cut stronger. TIP: use small dots of a liquid craft glue to allow extra time to adjust the placement.
- 4. Use small dots of a liquid glue to adhere the sequins for decoration.

5. Now, add the constructed panel to the front of the card base.

Make sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.



Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the red panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

And you did it!
