## **Let's Make Beautiful Things Together**

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because th situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ③ But you can always just use what you have!



### Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

#### Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 2 Kraft brown panels (1 with stitching)
- 3 Hillside pieces
- 4 Vellum die cuts (1 tree, 1 pumpkin,
- 2 leaves)
- 1 Vellum sentiment
- 1 Mailing liner
- (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)\*\*
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the Kraft brown panel with the stitching, the hillside pieces, the vellum sentiment and the vellum die cuts.

- 1. Begin by arranging the hillsides across the bottom of the stitched brown panel. Allow them to overlap each other to add interest. They will overhang the edge of the panel but that's okay. Once you have them adhered, turn the panel over and trim off any excess.
- 2. Next add the vellum die cuts to create a scene. See example picture for placement ideas. TIP: Vellum is TRICKY to adhere. Most all adhesive will show through to the front. I recommend using a very small application of glue only in spots that it might be hidden. I used tiny dots of glue behind only a few spots on each die cut, making sure to put it behind the white stamped lines.
- 3. Now add the sentiment. Find the placement you prefer and carefully fold the excess back over the top of the card front panel. See example picture for placement ideas. The fold-over adds interest and also stabilizes the vellum. To adhere it in place, add glue only to the areas where it won't be seen. Behind the heart and a few of the letters. Also, add glue to the back of the brown card panel where the vellum is folded, to keep it in place.
- 4. Now adhere your constructed card front to your card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the other Kraft brown panel to the inside of your card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

And you did it!
