## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



### Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

### Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White die cut pattern outline
- Red velvet flower pieces
- Green Leaf pieces
- 1 Gold piece
- 1 Merry die cut
- 1 Red panel
- 1 White panel
- Sequins
- Glue dots
- 1 Mailing liner  
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)\*\*
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the card base, the white die cut pattern outline, red flower pieces, green leaf pieces, the gold piece, the Merry die cut, the sequins and the glue dots. (Glue dots are needed for the velvet paper)

1. Let's begin by adhering the frame pattern die cut to the front of the card base. The frame will sit all the way from one edge to the other. Peel the release paper from the back and it will reveal adhesive over the entire die cut. This will make it much easier to adhere to the card base. Align the edges and press it down. Make sure to have the frame in the right direction, see example picture for placement ideas.
2. Now, empty out the red flower pieces and the green leaf pieces and determine their places. They will fit into the frame like a puzzle. Each piece has a unique shape and will only fit in one place. Once you know where everything goes, adhere the flower and leaf pieces in place. TIP: Add glue to the opening on the card base and set the piece on top of it to fit it in place.
3. Adhere the Merry die cut to the gold piece. Now adhere the decorated gold piece to the card front using liquid glue and/or glue dots. See example picture for placement ideas.
4. Now add the sequins for decoration. Use a liquid glue when adhering to paper. Use a glue dot when adhering to velvet.

**That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of our card.**

1. Adhere the red panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
2. Next, adhere the white panel over the red panel making sure to leave an even border of red showing along each edge.



**And you did it!**
