Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive 😊 But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 3 White card bases
- 3 Large white panels
- 3 Small white panels
- 3 Sets of die cut letters with trees
- 2 Red panels (Merry, Jingle)
- 1 Green panel (Peace)
- 3 Stamped sentiment strips
- 3 Foam panels
- 3 Mailing Liners**
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)
- 5 Coordinating envelopes*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first. Each card is constructed the same way. These instructions are for just one card.

You'll need a large white panel, 1 set of letter die cuts with trees (the trees will be used on the inside of the card), a sentiment strip and a foam panel.

1. To begin, arrange the letter die cuts on the white panel making sure to leave room for the sentiment. Once you are happy with the placement, adhere them into place. TIP: use a ruler or grid mat to help keep the letters straight.
2. Next, adhere the sentiment strip below the letters.
3. Now adhere the foam panel to the back of your decorated card front. (note: one side is adhesive backed)
4. Adhere your completed card front to the front of the card base, making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.



Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the colored panel (red or green) to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
2. Now add the white panel on the colored panel making sure to leave an even border of red (or green) showing along each edge.
3. Add the tree die cuts for decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.



And you did it!
