Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ③ But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 5 Black card bases
- 5 Red plaid panels
- 5 Merry and Bright die cuts
- 10 White panels
- 5 Long pieces of string for wrapping
- 5 Pieces of string for the bows
- 5 Foam panels
- 5 Coordinating envelopes*
- 5 Mailing Liners** (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first. Each card is constructed the same way. These instructions are for just one card. You'll need a black card base, a plaid panel, a white panel, a Merry and Bright die cut, a long string, a short string and a foam panel.

- 1. To begin, adhere the plaid panel to the white panel making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
- 2. Next, adhere Merry and Bright die cut to the layered plaid panel. See example picture for placement ideas. TIP: Use small dots of liquid glue for easy and clean placement.
- 3. Using the long string, wrap loops around the decorated panel and secure the ends with double sided tape to the back.
- 4. Tie a bow onto the loops you created with the long string. Use adhesive to secure it in place if it needs.
- 5. Adhere the foam panel to the back of the constructed card front and then adhere that to the front of the card base. (one side of the foam panel is adhesive backed)

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the white panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.

And you did it!
