Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Kraft brown card base
- 2 Ivory panels (1 small, 1 large)
- 1 Linen panel
- 1 Red and white patterned panel
- 4 Gift die cuts (1 red, 1 text, 1 pattern, 1 white)
- 2 Red strips
- 3 Glitter accent die cuts (1 scallop border, 1 bow, 1 extra bow loop)
- Foam squares
- Glue dots (inside folded paper)
- 1 Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the large ivory panel, the linen panel, 4 gift die cuts, 2 thin red strips, glitter accent die cuts, the foam squares, the glue dots and the card base.

1. Let's begin by constructing the gifts. Adhere the white rectangle to the back of the red and white patterned piece (the largest gift). It will help to stabilize that thin paper. Next, adhere one thin red strip across the horizontal center of that red and white patterned gift. Finish by adhering the other red strip down the vertical center of that same piece. Turn it over and trim any excess.
2. For the medium sized gift, adhere the scallop border along the top edge of the red Merry Christmas paper. Turn it over and trim any excess.
3. Before working on the last gift, let's build the front of the card. Using a strong double sided tape or a thin application of glue, adhere the linen panel to the large ivory panel. Make sure to leave an even border of ivory showing along each edge.
4. Now adhere that layered panel to the front of the kraft brown card base, making sure to leave an even border of brown showing along each edge.
5. Using foam squares, adhere all three gifts onto the card front. See example pictures for placement ideas.
6. To decorate the small gift, begin by adhering the extra bow loop to the front of the bow die cut. See example picture for placement ideas. TIP: use a small dot of liquid glue or a glue dot (included) for this.
7. Once the bow is ready, use a glue dot to adhere it to the top of the small gift.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of our card.

1. Adhere the red and white patterned panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of brown showing along each edge.
2. Next, adhere the small ivory panel onto the patterned panel, making sure to leave an even border showing along each edge.



And you did it!
