Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive 😊 But you can always just use what you have!

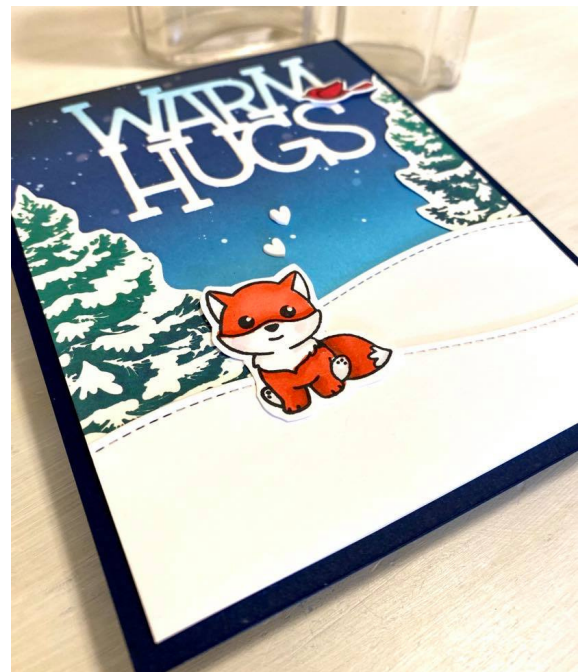


Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Navy card base
- 1 Ink blended panel
- 1 Stamped tree
- 1 Warm Hugs sentiment
- 1 Stamped fox
- 2 Stitched hillsides
- 2 Stamped birds
- 1 Stitched panel
- Heart embellishments
- Foam squares
- 1 Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the ink blended panel, the Warm Hugs die cut, the 2 hillsides, the fox, the tree, the bird facing left, the foam squares and the heart embellishments.

1. Begin by arranging the hillsides at the bottom of the inked panel. You can tilt or slide them around to create the hilly shape you're looking for. Once you are happy with the placement, adhere them in place and trim off any excess from behind.
2. Next, tuck the stamped tree behind the front hillside and allow it to hang off the left edge. Adhere it in place. Then turn the panel over and carefully trim off the excess to be used for the other tree element. Once it's trimmed, tuck the trimmed off piece behind the back hillside and align it with the right edge of the inked panel. Trim off any excess. This will give two tree elements for your card front. See example picture for placement ideas.
3. Now, using small dots of liquid glue, adhere the Warm Hugs die cut to the inked panel between the trees. See example picture for placement ideas.
4. Adhere the fox onto the front hillside. Use glue behind the body, but a foam square behind his head to level out the dimension difference.
5. Using a foam square, adhere the left facing bird onto the scene, over the sentiment. See example picture for placement ideas.
6. Use small dots of liquid glue to adhere the heart embellishments to the inked panel.
7. Finally, adhere the constructed card front to the card base.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the white stitched panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of blue showing along each edge.
2. Now adhere the remaining bird die cut for decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.

And you did it!
