Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive 😊 But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Black card base
- 2 White panels (1 small, 1 large)
- 1 White Sending Smiles word die cut with heart
- 1 Black backer for Sending Smiles
- 1 Baggie of die cuts including: 2 light blue houses, 2 dark blue houses (1 large, 1 small), 2 red houses (1 large, 1 small), 2 coral houses (1 large, 1 small), 3 light green trees with trunks, 5 dark green trees with trunks and yellow backers for all houses.
- Foam squares
- 1 Mailing liner (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the large white panel, the word die cut with the heart and black backer, the foam squares and all of the die cuts except 1 large dark green tree and a trunk.

1. Use small drops of liquid craft glue to adhere the Sending Smiles word onto its black backer. Then glue the heart to the center of the 'g', then set it aside.
2. Next, adhere the yellow backers to the back of each house die cut. There will be a Small, Medium and Large version. Note: the large backer will have a flat bottom and a peak at the top with rounded sides.
3. Now, using small dots of liquid glue, adhere the tree trunks to the back of each tree. The tall trees will use the tall trunks. Some trees won't need a trunk because of placement. See example picture for placement ideas.
4. Now arrange the constructed houses and trees onto the large white panel. Leave some to hang off the edge for added interest. I've included a picture of my placement for inspiration. Once you are satisfied, adhere everything in place. NOTE: Take care to keep the items straight. It can be easy to get them crooked. I recommend using a liquid glue to give more time for adjusting and align the white panel with something straight to help you see straight lol!
5. Once all items are glued into place, turn the panel over and trim off the excess.
6. Adhere the constructed card front to the card base.
7. Lastly, use foam squares to adhere the layered Sending Smiles to the front of the card. See example picture for placement ideas.



Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the white stitched panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of blue showing along each edge.
2. Now adhere the remaining bird die cut for decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.

And you did it!
