Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ☺ But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Navy card base
- 1 Navy stamped panel
- 1 White panel
- 6 Colored envelope die cuts
- 6 Scalloped edge stamped notes
- 3 Blank white scalloped notes
- 6 Colored heart stickers
- 1 Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the navy stamped panel, the 6 envelope die cuts, the scalloped notes, and the heart stickers.

1. Begin by constructing the envelope die cuts. Fold along each scored line and use a small amount of adhesive to glue the sides to the bottom flap. The top (largest) flap will remain open for now.
2. Now adhere the front of each envelope to the stamped navy panel. This allows the back of the envelope to be seen. See example picture for placement ideas.
3. Next, fold each scalloped note along the score line and insert it into the coordinating envelope. There are 3 white notes for you to use if you prefer. These have been left blank for your own message.
4. Once your notes have been added, seal each envelope with a matching heart sticker.
5. Now adhere the constructed card front to the navy card base making sure to leave an even border of navy showing along each edge.



Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

1. Adhere the white panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of navy showing along each edge.

And you did it!
