Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive ③ But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 Black card base

2 White panels (1 large, 1 small)

1 Ink blended (pink) die cut panel

1 Set of inked heart die cuts

1 Black circle stamped sentiment

1 White circle1 Small black circle (for inside the card)

1 Small pink heart (for inside the card)

1 Set sequins

1 Set foam squares

1 Mailing liner

(mailing liner only needed if you

mail your card)**

1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the larger white panel, the pink die cut panel, the black sentiment circle, the white circle, the set of pink hearts (not the small one), the sequins and the foam squares.

- 1. Using a liquid craft glue, adhere the pink die cut panel to the larger white panel. It will fit directly on top with all edges lining up. TIP: the liquid glue will allow a moment to adjust it in place
- 2. You will be adding the pink hearts in place over the open heart spaces. Determine the placement of the hearts so that the color variation matches the panel. The individual heart is not important, just each line of the color variation.
- 3. Next, add a foam square to the back of each heart. TIP: One side of the foam square has adhesive on it
- 4. Adhere each heart in place lining it up to fit in the open die cut space.
- 5. Now adhere this constructed card front panel to the front of the black card base, making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.
- 6. Adhere the black sentiment circle to the white circle leaving an even border of white showing along each edge. Now adhere the layered circle to the front of the card. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 7. Using small dots of liquid glue, adhere the sequins to the card front for added decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.

Now let's decorate the inside of our card!

- 1.Adhere the small black circle to the smaller white panel. Trim off any excess. See example picture for placement ideas. Add the small pink heart for decoration.
- 2. Adhere the decorated white panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.

And you did it!
