Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 2 Large gray panels (1 dark, 1 light)
- 1 Small gray panel
- 1 Coral panel
- 1 Heart die cut panel
- 12 Colored strips
- 2 Sentiment sets (stamped circle, white ring, black rectangle, thanks sticker with frame)
- Heart die cuts
- Foam panel and foam squares (one side is adhesive backed)
- 1 Mailing liner (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*





We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the large dark gray and small gray panels, the heart die cut panel, the colored strips, the sentiment pieces and the foam squares.

1. This kit includes 2 design styles for you to choose from. There is a blue set and a peach set. In addition to that, you can choose the sentiment that fits best.
2. Once you've chosen your color set, adhere the strips to the back of the heart die cut panel. Use the example picture for placement ideas. TIP: you might need to overlap the colored strips to make sure the stripe shows through the front completely.
3. Now adhere the constructed heart panel to the smaller gray panel making sure to leave an even border showing along each edge.
4. Next, adhere that layered panel to the dark gray panel making sure to leave an even border showing along each edge.
5. Next, choose the sentiment. I'm here for you: Use a small amount of adhesive to glue the white ring to the outside edge of the stamped circle. Thanks: Remove the release paper from the back of the word die cut and the frame. Carefully adhere them to the black rectangle. Adhere the finished sentiment to the center of the heart panel using a foam square.
6. Finally, use the foam panel to adhere the constructed card front to the card base. Make sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Choose the light gray or coral panel and adhere it to the inside of the card base.
2. Next, decorate the panel with the heart die cuts. See example picture for placement ideas.

And you did it!
