Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Kraft brown card base
- 2 White panels (1 large, 1 small)
- 1 Leaf pattern paper
- 1 Black panel
- 1 Sentiment die cut set
(1 black background, 2 white words)
- 1 Black stamped sentiment
- Heart die cuts
- Foam Squares
- 1 Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the card base, the large white panel, the leaf panel, the sentiment die cuts, the stamped sentiment, the heart die cuts and the foam squares.

1. First adhere the 2 white word die cuts on top of each other. This adds dimension to the sentiment. Next adhere the stacked word die cuts to the black shadow die cut, making sure to leave an even border of black showing along the edge. Set aside.
2. Now, adhere the leaf paper to the large white panel making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
3. Using foam squares, adhere the layered sentiment and the stamped sentiment to the center of the leaf panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
4. Add the die cut hearts for added decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.
5. Finish by adhering the completed card front to the card base, making sure to leave an even border of kraft brown showing along each edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the black panel to the inside of the card base.
2. Next, adhere the small white panel to the black panel making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge. The black border will be narrow.

And you did it!
