

# Kit A

## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

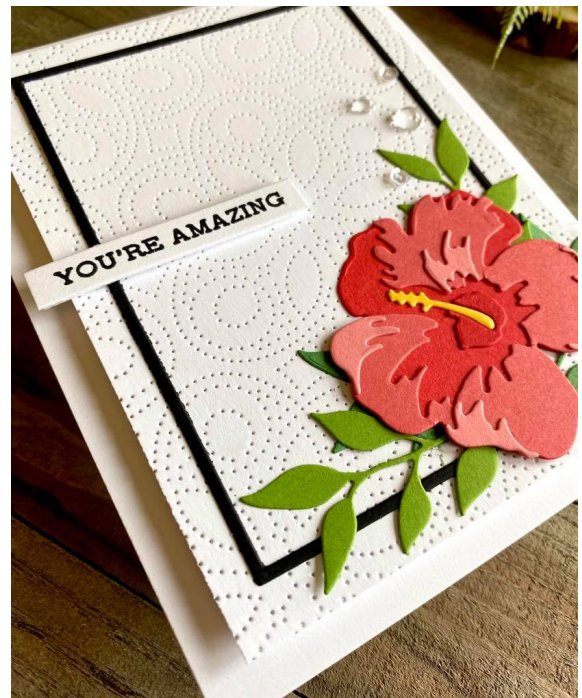
Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White pierced panel
- 1 Black frame
- 1 Set of Flower die cuts
- 1 Set of shiny embellishments
- 1 Stamped sentiment
- 1 Red panel
- 1 Foam strip and foam panel (adhesive backed)
- 1 Mailing liner (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)\*\*
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the pierced panel, black frame, stamped sentiment, foam strip, flower die cuts, and embellishments.

1. Let's begin by constructing the flower. Use small amounts of glue to adhere the layered pieces together. Take care to match the outside edges where applicable. Follow the steps in the example pictures.
2. Now, using small dots of liquid glue, adhere the black frame to the pierced panel making sure to leave an even border along each edge.
3. Arrange the green leaf die cuts to create a layered background for the flower. Adhere in place. See example picture for placement ideas.
4. Using a strong adhesive (liquid craft glue or strong double sided tape), adhere the flower in place over the leaves.
5. Add the foam strip to the back of the stamped sentiment and adhere it to the panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
6. Finally, using small dots of liquid glue, adhere the embellishments for decoration.
7. (For optional dimension) Add the foam panel to the back of your card front panel and adhere it to the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.





**That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.**

1. Adhere the red panel to the inside of the card making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

**And you did it!**
