Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 Navy card base
2 Blue stitched panels (1 inked)
1 Skyline die cut
Cloud die cuts (3 large, 2 small, 2 white
borders, 1 vellum border
Bunny and Umbrella die cuts
Hi sentiment die cuts
Foam Squares
1 Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you
mail your card)**
1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the inked blue stitched panel, the skyline die cut, the Bunny and Umbrella, the "Hi" die cut, the 3 large clouds, the white border cloud and the vellum border cloud.

- 1. First decide the position of the skyline. You will need to lower it off the inked panel to allow enough room for the rest of the scene. Adhere in place and trim off the excess.
- 2. Next adhere the vellum cloud border to the top of the card panel making sure to only put adhesive along the very top edge where it will be covered, otherwise it will show through.
- 3. Now adhere the white cloud border and 3 clouds. See example picture for placement ideas. Trim off excess.
- 4. Use foam squares to adhere the Bunny and Umbrella to the card front. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 5. Now adhere the "Hi" sentiment. TIP: use very small dots of glue to adhere the Hi first. Then add a dot of glue to the panel and place the "dot" onto it for placement. Tweezers or a Jewel Picker can help
- 6. Finally, adhere the decorated Card Front panel to the card base making sure to leave an even border of Navy showing along each edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

- 1. Adhere the remaining cloud border and 2 small clouds onto the remaining blue panel. See example picture for placement ideas. Trim off excess.
- 2. Adhere the decorated panel to the inside of the card base.



And you did it!
