Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White grid die cut
- White heart die cuts
- Sequins
- 4 Hello die cuts (3 white, 1 vellum)
- 2 White panels (1 large, 1 small)
- 1 Set of multicolored die cut squares
- 3 Colored strips
- 3 Extra die cut squares (white)
- 1 Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the white grid die cut, the hearts, the sequins, the larger white panel, the colored squares, and the Hello die cuts.

1. Begin by constructing the Hello sentiment. I included the vellum outline piece in the kit- but this is optional for you depending on what looks good to you. Adhere the Hello die cuts on top of each other to create a dimensional sentiment. For my example card, I used 2 Hello's, then the vellum outline, then the third Hello behind the vellum. This gave some lift off of the panel.
2. Next, construct the colorful grid panel. Using a thin line of liquid craft glue on each line, adhere the grid die cut to the large white panel. The edges should meet up on every side. You can trim any excess later.
3. Once the grid is in place, use small dots of liquid glue to add the colorful squares. Use the example picture to guide your design. Some squares will hang over the edges, you will trim those later. It will help to organize the squares by color before you begin. The white squares are extra in case you need a replacement. To use them, color them with a matching marker first. OR, leave them white for added interest.
4. Once the grid pattern is finished, trim any excess and adhere the constructed panel to the card base. It will fit edge to edge.
5. Next, add the Hello die cut stack to the card front. Finish by decorating with the heart die cuts and sequins. See example picture for placement ideas.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of our card.

1. Cut the colored strips in half. Use 1 half of each color, in opposite corners, to decorate the smaller white panel. Trim any excess. See example picture for placement ideas.
2. Adhere the decorated white panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.



And you did it!
