

Groove Is In The Heart

Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White panel
- 1 Hi die cut set
- 1 Set of Heart pieces
- 1 White Heart backer
- 1 Mustard panel (inside of card)
- 2 Adhesive backed foam pieces (optional)
- 1 Mailing liner (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the white panel, the Heart pieces, the white heart backer, the Hi die cut set and the foam pieces (optional). TIP: When using a liquid craft glue on paper, a light application works best.

1. Begin by constructing the Heart. **Start** at the bottom and work your way to the top. Using a double sided tape or liquid craft glue, adhere the heart pieces onto the white heart backer fitting them together so they align on all edges. There will be some slight overhang past the white backer. That's intentional so that it isn't seen when the heart is finished. TIP: Using a liquid craft glue allows time to adjust placement as needed
2. Next, adhere the Hi die cut pieces to the bottom right corner of the white panel (this is not the card base). See example picture for placement ideas. I recommend you add small dots of liquid glue to the back of the "hi" and adhere it to the panel first. Then, add a tiny dot of glue onto the white panel where you will place the dot of the i. Place the dot onto the glue being careful not to squeeze out excess glue. TIP: Using tweezers to hold small pieces might help placement.
3. Adhere the constructed Heart to the white panel. (Optional) For added dimension, remove one side of the release paper from the foam pieces and adhere them to the back of the Heart. Remove the rest of the release paper and adhere the Heart to the white panel. See example picture for placement ideas. TIP: Take care when adhering the Heart, the foam adhesive is strong and isn't easily adjusted
4. Finally, using liquid craft glue or double sided tape, adhere the constructed white panel (card front) to the front of the card base. Make sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Using a liquid craft glue or double sided tape, adhere the Mustard panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.



And you did it!
