## Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

### Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

### Contents:

- 1 Black card base
- 1 Black panel
- 11 Number die cuts
- 1 Light blue panel
- 1 Balloon and string die cut
- Sequins
- 1 Stamped Sentiment
- 1 Vellum rectangle
- 1 Foam panel-adhesive backed (optional)
- 1 Foam squares and rectangle (optional)
- 1 Mailing liner  
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)\*\*
- 1 Coordinating envelope\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the black panel, the number die cuts, the sequins, the stamped sentiment, the vellum, and the foam squares and rectangle.

1. Adhere the number die cuts onto the black panel (not the card base), reserving a few of the numbers to adhere with foam squares. You can arrange these in ANY way, giving you the option to highlight a certain number if you want. To follow my pattern, Adhere the 3, 0, 6, 8, 0, 2, 9. Allow some edges to overlap other numbers and also hang over the edge of the panel. Lastly adhere the 4, 7, 5, 1 with foam squares (optional) for added dimension. See example picture for placement ideas. Turn panel over and trim any excess if you want.
2. Now, adhere the stamped sentiment to the vellum backer leaving an even border of vellum showing along each edge. Then use the foam rectangle (optional) to adhere the sentiment to the decorated panel.
3. Using small dots of liquid glue, adhere the sequins to the constructed panel for decoration.
4. Using the foam panel, adhere the constructed card front to the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.

**That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of our card.**

1. Adhere the balloon string to the back of the balloon die cut, aligning it with the balloon tie. Then adhere the finished balloon to the light blue panel and trim any excess. See example picture for placement ideas.
2. Adhere the light blue panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.
