# You Had Me At Hello

## **Let's Make Beautiful Things Together**

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



### Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

#### Contents:

1 White card base

1 Pink panel

1 Aqua dot panel

1 Light blue panel

1 White frame

1 Black Hello die cut

1 Strip of adhesive backed foam

(Optional-for Hello)

1 Mailing liner

(mailing liner only needed if you

mail your card)\*\*

1 Coordinating envelope\*



## Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the Pink panel, the Aqua dot panel, the white frame, the black Hello and the foam adhesive (optional). TIP: When using a liquid craft glue on paper, a light application works best.

- 1. Using a liquid craft glue or double sided tape, adhere the Aqua dot panel over top of the Pink panel making sure to align each side. There is No 'right' way to use the dot panel, pick which direction you like most. See example picture for placement ideas. TIP: Using a liquid craft glue allows time to adjust placement as needed
- 2. Next, adhere the white frame to the layered Aqua panel. I recommend using a glue pen or sparing dots of liquid glue for this and arrange it to leave an even border along each edge. TIP: Tweezers might help with placement
- 3. Adhere the Hello die cut to the Aqua dot panel. (Optional) For added dimension, add the small segments of foam strips to the back of the Hello die cut. See picture for placement ideas. Remove the release paper and adhere the foam backed Hello to the Aqua panel.
- 4. Finally, using liquid craft glue or double sided tape, adhere the layered Aqua dot panel (card front) to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.



## That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Using a liquid craft glue or double sided tape, adhere the Light blue panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
