Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!




Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

1 Gray card base 2 Gray panels (1 inked) Flower die cuts- 2 pink, 2 white and 2 gray (adhesive backed) 2 Leaf die cuts (adhesive backed) 1 Mom die cut sentiment set (white backer, gray letters) 1 Stamped sentiment Sequins 1 Heart embellishment 1 Foam panel and foam squares (adhesive backed) 1 Mailing liner (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)** 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the flower and leaf die cuts (reserve one gray flower for the inside of the card), the inked gray panel (the other is for the inside of the card), the Mom die cut set, the stamped sentiment, sequins and the foam panel and foam squares.

- 1. Begin by adhering the flower and leaf die cuts to the inked gray panel. Remove the release paper from the back and it will become a sticker. Arrange them so that some edges overhang. Trim any excess. See example picture below for placement ideas. TIP:Use any excess pieces to fill in empty areas
- 2. Next, adhere the gray MOM letters to the white die cut backer. Using foam squares, adhere the constructed MOM die cut to the decorated panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 3. Adhere the stamped sentiment "Happy Mother's Day" using the thin foam strip.
- 4. Finally, using small dots of liquid craft glue, adhere the sequins for decoration.
- 5. Use the foam panel to adhere the decorated card front to the gray card base. Make sure to leave an even border of gray showing along each edge.





That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of our card.

- 1. Adhere the remaining gray flower to the light gray panel. Trim any excess. Add the white heart for decoration. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 2. Adhere the gray panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of dark gray showing along each edge.

And you did it!
