Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 Light blue dotted panel
- 1 Red panel
- 1 Stamped sentiment
- 1 Red/White gumball machine (3 pieces)
- 1 Teal panel- lined
- 1 Set gumball pieces
- 2 Foam pieces (adhesive backed)
- 1 Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the light blue panel, the gumball machine die cuts, the sentiment, the teal lined panel, the gumball pieces and the foam pieces.

1. Begin by adhering the teal panel at the bottom of the light blue panel. Trim any overhanging edges. See example picture for placement ideas.
2. Next, adhere the gumball machine die cut pieces together. Adhere the cap piece at the top of the white bowl piece. Next, adhere the top edge of the base piece to the bottom line of the bowl. See example picture for placement ideas.
3. With scissors, trim the large foam piece to make 2 squares to use behind the gumball machine. TIP: RESERVE some of the foam to use behind some of the gumballs for added dimension
4. Now use the two foam squares you cut to adhere the gumball machine to the layered teal panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
5. Next, adhere the gumballs to the panel. Reserve some for the inside of the card. I reserved 3 dark blue, 3 light blue, and 2 glitter. Adhere some to the gumball machine for decoration. Then add more gumballs to the dark teal panel. Finally add one gumball sticking out from under the 5¢ flap for decoration. See example picture for placement ideas. TIP: Add small squares of foam under some of the gumballs for added interest.
6. Use the thin foam rectangle to adhere the stamped sentiment to the decorated panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
7. Finally, adhere the finished panel to the front of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the remaining gumballs to the red panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
2. Adhere the decorated red panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
