Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!

Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 Black card base
- 1 Black panel
- 1 Stamped sentiment
- 20 Circle rings in rainbow colors (3 for the inside of the card)
- 1 Black circle die cut
- 1 White panel
- 1 Foam panel and foam square (adhesive backed)
- 1 Mailing liner (mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the black panel, the stamped sentiment, 17 rainbow circle rings, the black circle die cut, the card base and the foam pieces.

1. Begin by constructing the rainbow circle. You will build the rainbow circles on the black circle die cut, it will act as the backer. For adhesive, I have 2 recommendations. 1: Use a tape/dot runner in the pattern of a spoked wheel with lines coming out from the center. Plus, add a line of adhesive around the outer rim of the circle backer. This will allow you to place the rings onto the adhesive as you go. 2: Use a glue pen or small dots of liquid glue on each ring as you position them
2. Begin with the smallest circle (light green). Adhere it to the center of the black circle backer. The position is marked for you with an embossed line.
3. Next, adhere rainbow rings in order from smallest to largest as you work your way out.
4. Because of the flexibility of paper, you might notice the rings shifting off center. Do your best to keep them straight, but don't fret this too much.
5. Once all of the rainbow rings are in place, decide the position of the decorated circle on the black square panel (not the card base). Adhere it in place and trim the excess. See example picture for placement ideas. TIP: If the rings ended up being off center, position the circle in a way that uses the best part of it, leaving the off centered portion to hang off the panel to be trimmed.
6. Attach the foam panel behind the decorated black panel and then adhere them to the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.
7. Using the foam strip, adhere the stamped sentiment to the card front. See example picture for placement ideas.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of our card.

1. Adhere the remaining 3 colored circles to the white panel. Trim any excess. See example picture for placement ideas.
2. Adhere the decorated white panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.



And you did it!
