Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

- 1 White card base
- 1 White panel- stamped Sending Smiles
- 4 Rainbow die cut pieces
- 2 Cloud die cuts
- 1 Set of embellishments (sequins/heart)
- 1 Grapefruit colored panel
- 1 Foam panel- adhesive backed
- 1 Rainbow patterned envelope liner
- 1 Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the white stamped panel, the rainbow pieces, the clouds, the embellishments and the foam panel.

- 1.Begin by adhering the rainbow pieces to the Sending Smiles panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 2. Next, adhere the 2 clouds to each side of the rainbow. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 3. Using small dots of liquid glue, adhere the embellishments to the rainbow panel for decoration.
- 4. Add the foam panel to the back of the rainbow panel and then adhere that to the front of the card base. Make sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

- 1. Adhere the grapefruit colored panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
- 2. Finally, slide the rainbow patterned envelope liner into the envelope. Align the score line of the patterned paper with the fold line of the closing flap. The pattern should be facing you so it's seen when the envelope is opened. Adhere the rainbow liner to the envelope along the top edges. See envelope liner example picture.
