Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

White card base
White and green stamped panel
White frame piece
Vespa and I balloon die cut
Black hello
Black panel
Green stamped panel
Set of foam pieces- adhesive backed
Mailing liner
(mailing liner only needed if you mail your card)**
Coordinating envelope*



Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the white and green stamped panel, the white frame, the hello die cut, the Vespa and balloon die cuts, and the foam pieces.

- 1.Add the foam pieces to the back of the white frame. The three long pieces are to go along the thin edges of the frame. These foam pieces have adhesive and release paper on both sides. Use the foam square on the larger section of the frame. This foam has adhesive and release paper on only One side. TIP: The smallest strips of foam are to help behind some of the other elements.
- 2. Remove the release paper and add adhesive where needed, then adhere the frame piece to the white and green stamped panel. I tilted mine to add interest. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 3. Next adhere the Vespa die cut to the frame. Only add glue/adhesive where needed. Add the small pieces of foam to help support any overhanging sections. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 4. Now adhere the balloons die cut to the vespa and frame.
- 5. Adhere the hello die cut to the frame only adding adhesive where needed. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 6. Finally, adhere the constructed card front to the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.

That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

- 1. Adhere the green panel to the black panel making sure to leave an even border of black showing along each edge.
- 2. Finally, adhere the layered green and black panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
