Let's Make Beautiful Things Together

Just some info: ADHERE means to stick your card elements together using a tape runner, a double sided tape, a liquid craft glue or any combination of those. If I specify a type of adhesive, that's because the situation will work BEST using the recommended adhesive. But you can always just use what you have!



Where to Start?

First confirm you have all card elements and pre-plan your card layout. Just to get an idea of how you want it to look.

Contents:

White card base
 White panel (backer)
 Set of stripes (5 orange 4 white)
 Set of flower die cut pieces
 flowers, 2 centers, 1 stem)
 Stamped sentiment
 Yellow panel
 Set of foam pieces- adhesive backed
 Coordinating envelope*




Let's Begin!

We'll construct the card front first.

You'll need the white panel, the stripes, the flower pieces, the stamped sentiment and the foam pieces.

- 1. Begin by adding the stripes to the white backer panel. Alternate colors starting at the top with an orange piece. Align the stripe even with the panel horizontally but allow an even amount to hang off each end, keeping the stripe mostly centered. This will give the "center highlight" appearance when you're done. When all stripes are adhered, turn the panel over and trim the excess from the sides.
- 2. Next, construct the flower. Align and adhere the smaller flower piece over the larger one. See construction picture for directions. Now adhere the two brown center pieces to the flower making sure the textured piece is on top.
- 3. Use the foam square to adhere the flower head to the striped panel. See example picture for placement ideas.
- 4. Now, add the green stem by tucking it under the flower and adhering it in to place. Trim off any excess.

5. Using the thin foam strip (optional), adhere the stamped sentiment to the flower. See example picture for placement ideas. NOTE: The foam strip has a release paper on both sides.
6. Finally, use the foam panel to adhere the constructed card front to the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge. One side of the panel has adhesive, for the other side, you'll need to add your own.



That's it! Now let's decorate the inside of the card.

1. Adhere the yellow panel to the inside of the card base making sure to leave an even border of white showing along each edge.
